### 2 Warrant

By submitting an application, you warrant to the Committee;

a. that the applicant producer or director retains the right and has the power to grant the licence/permission to the screening of the film and that there will be no obstacles to the screening of the film at the Festival,

b. and that you have obtained all required permits and licences and that your submission is in no way a violation of any existing copyright including music and existing characters.

The Committee will not be liable for any claims for infringement of rights or damages from third parties.

#### 3 How to apply

a. Fill in all the fields below and send to the Office.

b. Upload 1) Director's portrait photo data (height 800 x width 600 pixels or more recommended) and 2) three still images of the film (height 720 x width 1280 pixels or more recommended).

These images will be displayed on the official festival website, flyers, brochures and other promotional materials.

(\*Please note that the images may be cropped for use by the Office).

# 4. Subtitles and translation

Japanese-language films shall be screened with English subtitles. Please send us your DCP or data with English subtitles. Alternatively, upon your authorisation, we will also screen your film on Blu-ray with English subtitles. If you only have subtitle data or translations, please provide them to us.

- 5. the Office will decide on the programme arrangement and screening
- 6. Media Format and Upload
  - (1) Please send your film using the storage service specified by the Festival.
  - (4) The film in one of the following file formats.

DCP / ProRes / H.264

# 7 Other conditions of understanding

a. The Committee will charge the audience to view the films in the Festival.

b. The applicant acknowledges that the Festival may use a portion of the film (not more than 5% of the total length of the film) and any images submitted for the Festival's publicity purposes.

c. The materials of the submitted films will not be destroyed or returned, but will be stored and utilised in the Niigata International Animation Festival Library.

8. The Committee or the Office will decide on all matters not covered by these terms and conditions.
